We deliver a fun, varied and structured curriculum with opportunities to perform and take part in examinations. Students learn songs in styles ranging from traditional to contemporary.

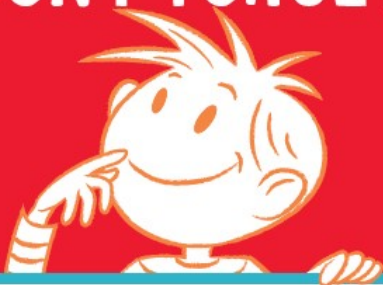
