Winter Illness

Measles

To add to our COVID woes the Ministry of Health have let schools know that Measles is likely to rear its head again this winter. They have advised us the best way to avoid Measles is to get yourself and your child/ren immunised. They are suggesting families check they are immunised.

The symptoms are: Fever, runny nose, cough and sometimes pink watery eyes. In some cases small white spots in the mouth. Followed by a splotchy red rash.


We have been advised should we get an outbreak here at school that children who are not immunised will be asked to stay at home to keep safe.

COVID19

Please continue to follow the guidelines below.

- Regularly wash and dry your hands
- Cough or sneeze into a disposable tissue or into your elbow
- Practice physical distancing if you don't know someone
- Stay home if you're unwell and seek advice about getting tested
- It is recommended that facemasks should be worn

Please do NOT send your child to school if they are sick. If your child is displaying COVID symptoms at school we will be ringing you to come and collect them. Your child will need to be symptom free for 24 hours to return back to school. Thank you for your support.
